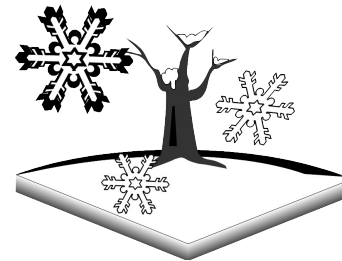
### *Financial Aid*
